- I. Comprehension of Your Position in Christ
  - A. Crucifixion of the **Sinful Nature** (vs 6-7)

6 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with *Him,* that the body of sin might be done away with that we should no longer be slaves of sin. 7 For he who has died has been freed from sin.

- I. Comprehension of Your Position in Christ (vs 5, 8-9)
  - B. Provision of Resurrection Power

5 For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, 8 Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, 9 knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him.

- II. Appropriation of Your Power in Christ
  - A. Daily Claiming the <u>Crucifixion</u> of Your Sin Nature (vs 11)

11 Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

#### III. Submission to the Lordship of Christ

A. Continual Coronation (vs 12-14)

12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. 13 And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God. 14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

#### III. Submission to the Lordship of Christ

B. Continual **Transformation** (vs 13-14)

13 And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God. 14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law But under grace.
